If you indicated the need for a lunch voucher on your registration form and did not receive one, please see an MCH staff member or volunteer in the Fellowship Room at Christ Capitol Hill (105 University Ave W, St Paul).

Transportation - MCH is offering **limited but free** Metro Transit passes to use between Central Presbyterian Church (10th Street Exit) and the State Capitol. It is a 15-20 minute walk from the church to the Capitol or one stop on the Green Line LRT. *Light rail passes are limited and available at registration and in Christ Capitol Hill (105 University Ave W) after 10:30 A.M.*
